The Third Semester Teaching Plan

Teaching Semester

2021-2022, Autumn Semester: 27th September, 2021 – 16th January, 2022 (including the final exam and three weeks of break).

Subject Type

Elective courses (It is recommended that schools set up by 2-4 credits.)

Teaching Model

Comprehensive course + Tutoring

Class Duration& Schedule

- ✧ Duration: 13 weeks. (September 27th, 2021 - January 16th, 2022.)
- ✧ Holidays: Chinese National Day holiday (October 1st-7th, 2021),
Christmas and New Year's Day holidays (December 24th, 2021-January 6th, 2022).
- ✧ Schedule: 4 classes/ week: 2 times/ week, 2 classes/ time (90 minutes.)

Information of Classes

- ✧ **400 students, 20 students/class**
- ✧ **Level 1:** Beginners and students who are interested in learning Chinese are all welcomed to sign up. After finish this level, you can pass HSK 1 test.
- ✧ **Level 2:** For those who have completed course of the first level, or at least have mastered the basic pronunciation of Chinese, about 150 Chinese vocabulary, and can recognize and read about 100 Chinese characters. (Students who have completed the first phase of study and did not continue to the second phase of study, or students who have signed up for the second phase for some reason but failed to complete the study or have the corresponding learning foundation can sign up) .
- ✧ **Level 3:** For those who have completed First Level 2, or have mastered about 500 Chinese vocabulary and can recognize and read about 300 Chinese characters (students who have completed the second phase of the online Chinese class or students with corresponding learning

foundation can sign up).

Note: The number of classes at each level will be finalized based on the number of enrolled students.

Requirements:

- ✧ Before Class: Students sign Agreement of Learning Chinese.
- ✧ During Class: At least 80% attendance rate, class participation, online learning records.
- ✧ After class: After school practice, final test, HSK 1-3 test.

Learning Reward

Students who have completed the course and passed the exam will not only get the course completion certificate issued by the Center for Language Education and Cooperation of the Ministry of Education of China, but also automatically obtain the membership of the "Great Wall Chinese" club and enjoy the membership treatment. Students with excellent grades have the opportunity to come to China and participate the China Summer Camp.

Teaching Plan

CLASS A (Level 1)

Teaching Goals:

Understand the phonetic features of Chinese, initially master about 240 Chinese vocabulary, 40 grammatical points, 80 common Chinese sentences, and 150 Chinese characters; able to communicate briefly on the most familiar topics such as personal information, daily life, etc.; able to speak the simplest polite language and identify simple information in the public environment.

Class B (Level 2)

Teaching Goal

Able to read about 400 commonly used Chinese characters, master about 600 vocabulary and 80 language points. Preliminary mastery of primary listening and speaking skills centered on survival and communication. Topics include: date conversation, direction and location, describing objects, asking directions, asking prices when shopping, ordering, making phone calls, discussing locations, transportation, and seeking help, etc.

Class C (Level 3)

Teaching Goal

Able to read about 700 commonly used Chinese characters, master about 1200 vocabulary and 120

language points. Master the basic primary listening and speaking skills centered on personal daily life. Topics include: talking about the weather, talking about ongoing actions, talking about people's habits, talking about living environment, mailing letters and delivering, receiving packages, exchanges, depositing and withdrawing Money, shopping, seeing a doctor, recreational activities, talking about a certain past behavior or event, etc.
