THE TEACHING PLAN OF THE Seventh PHASE

◆ Teaching Semester/Teaching Object

The online Chinese class at the University of the Aegean in Greece is still for all the students and teachers of the university.

The Winter Semester of 2023 which is the seventh Phase lasts for 13 weeks. It's planned to start on October 16th, 2023 and end on January 12th, 2024.

◆ Class Setting

Class A: LevelII(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – First Level). Beginners and students who are interested in learning Chinese are all welcome to sign up.

Class B: LevelIII(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Second Level). For those who have completed the course of LevelII(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – First Level), or at least have mastered the basic Chinese pronunciation, about 150 primary Chinese words, can read about 100 Chinese characters and speak more than 30 sentences, or students with the corresponding learning foundation can all sign up.

Class C: LevelIII(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Third Level), for those who have completed LevelIII(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Second Level), or have mastered about 300 Chinese words, can read about 200 Chinese characters and speak more than 60 sentences, or students with the corresponding learning foundation can all sign up.

Class D: Level IV(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Fourth Level), for those who have completed LevelIII(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Third Level), or have mastered about 500 Chinese words, can read about 300 Chinese characters and speak more than 100 sentences,or students with corresponding learning foundation can all sign up.

Class E: Level V(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Fifth Level), for those who have completed LevelIV(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Fourth Level), or have mastered more than 700 Chinese words, can read more than 400 Chinese characters and speak more than 150 sentences,or students with corresponding learning foundation can all sign up.

Class F: LevelVI(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Sixth Level), for those who have completed Level V(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Fifth Level), or have mastered more than 1000 Chinese words, can read more than 500 Chinese characters and speak more than 200 sentences,or students with corresponding learning foundation can all sign up.

Class G: LevelVII(Great Wall Chinese-Progression in Communication – First Level), for those who have completed LevelVI(Great Wall Chinese-Essentials in Communication – Sixth Level), or have mastered more than 1300 Chinese words, can read more than 600 Chinese characters and speak more than 250 sentences,or students with corresponding learning foundation can all sign up. The total enrollment planned for this semester is 400. The specific number of students can be adjusted after registration.

◆ **Teacher Staffing**

There are seven Chinese levels and 16 teaching classes which have been set up in the seventh phase of the online Chinese class at the University of the Aegean. 1 Program Teaching Supervisor, 16 teachers, 8 teaching assistants, 2 supervision experts, 1 teaching secretary, 1 technical director and 8 technical support have been arranged.

◆ **Teaching Plan**

The Seventh Phase of the online Chinese class at the University of the Aegean in Greece lasts for 13 weeks. Two teaching periods are scheduled every week, and each lasts for 90 minutes. It's planned to start on October 16th, 2023 and end on January 12th, 2024.

◆ Teaching Method

All classes adopt a comprehensive teaching mode, implement the teaching principle of combining speaking with practice and taking the lead in listening and speaking, adhere to the principle that Chinese is the main teaching language while English as a supplement. All classes need to strengthen the **application-oriented teaching concept**: to select the typical usage of the vocabulary in different contexts in **vocabulary** teaching, so that learners can learn the correct use of vocabulary in the context; to guide students to understand grammatical meaning in the context in **grammar** teaching so as to improve students' ability to form words and sentences; to combine closely with the HSK exam, simulate the HSK real question types in both class teaching and after-class **practice**, and arrange the simulated exam to help students familiarize themselves with the real question types and difficulty, and accumulate exam experience.

In order to increase the interactivity and fun of online teaching, **small games and video resources** are used during pre-class preview. The "Hanya Cultural Park" video is specially provided for students to learn. Teachers are also encouraged to use online multimedia resources to enrich the content of classroom teaching, integrate cultural teaching into the classroom, and enable learners to have more interest and understanding of Chinese language and culture.

To improve students' speaking ability, emphasis is placed on **precise speaking and practice**, and to **enhance their language output**. Simplified classroom teaching language is used to guide students in learning and understanding new content, and a combination of graphics and text is used to help students quickly understand. Context creation, questioning, or practice are used to guide students in expressing their output, while after-school exercises are also used to help students review and consolidate learning content.

◆ Teaching Content and Goals

Class A(Level I): Understand the phonetic features of Chinese, initially master about 180 Chinese words, 40 grammatical points, 40 common Chinese sentences, and 120 Chinese characters; able to communicate briefly on the most familiar topics such as personal information, daily life, etc.; able to speak the simple polite language and identify simple information in the public environment. Students with good attendance and excellent grades can pass HSK1 Test.

Class B (Level II): Able to master more than 400 Chinese words, 50 Chinese grammatical points and 60 commonly used sentences, and can read 200 Chinese characters. Preliminary mastery of primary listening and speaking skills centered on survival and communication. Topics include: date, direction and location, describing objects, asking directions, asking prices when shopping, ordering, making phone calls, discussing locations, transportation, and seeking help, etc. Qualified students with good attendance can pass HSK1 Test and students with excellent grades can pass HSK2 Test.

Class C (Level Ⅲ): Able to master more than 700 Chinese words, 60 Chinese grammatical points and 100 commonly used sentences, and can read 300 Chinese characters. Master the basic primary listening and speaking skills centered on personal daily life. Topics include: talking about the weather, ongoing actions, people's habits, living environment, mailing letters and delivering, receiving packages, depositing and withdrawing money, shopping, seeing a doctor, etc., be able to express using the past, the present and the future tense, be able to express personal demands clearly, etc.. Qualified students with good attendance can pass HSK2 Test, and try to challenge HSK3 Test.

Master the basic primary listening and speaking skills centered on personal daily life. Topics include: talking about study, examination, hobbies and interests, impressions on people or things, working environment and arrangements, learning about the steps of various procedures, be able to master the basic expressions related to parties, be able to express topics like invitation, dating and weekend plans etc. completely. Students with good attendance and excellent grades can pass HSK3 Test.

Class E (Level V): Able to master more than 1200 Chinese words, 60 Chinese grammatical points and 180 commonly used sentences, can read about 500 Chinese characters. Master the basic primary listening and speaking skills centered on personal daily life. Topics include: talking about study, life, hobbies, interests and ideals, talking about and making comments on working environment and sports exercise, understand the basic cultural content of Chinese festivals and

customs, can express personal likes and dislikes, the demanding expressions related to joining a party or declining an invitation, be able to express completely and make comments on weekend dating or arrangements, etc. After completing the study of this period, qualified students with good attendance can pass HSK3 Test, and can try to challenge HSK4 Test.

Topics include: talking about festivals, life, weather conditions, be able to check in and check out at hotels, introduce the servicing facilities, book hotels and reserve restaurants, be familiar with the procedures of online shopping, talking about and making comments on travelling plans and sports exercise, understand the cultural content of Chinese festivals and customs, be able to express personal preference and wishes completely, be able to express completely and make comments on the basic topics related to society. Students with good attendance can take the HSK4 Test training under the guidance of the teacher.

Master the basic primary listening and speaking skills centered on personal daily life. Topics include: talking about sports, advertisement, business activities, cities, etc., be able to describe activity plan and progress, to express one's true thoughts, to compare the climate differences, to describe one's personal situation and experience, to express regret or apology, to express one's compression on cities, to refuse directly with different reasons or persuade others, be able to express completely and make comments on the basic topics related to society. Students with good attendance can take the HSK4 Test training under the guidance of the teacher.
